

FAQ:

1. Can I bring my family?
 - No. Family members are not allowed during the duration of this course.
2. Can I bring my pets?
 - No.
3. How much money should I bring?
 - We recommend \$1000.00 to make all of the necessary purchases needed to complete the course. As an Officer in the Army, you are required to purchase your uniforms and accessories.
4. Can I bring my vehicle?
 - Yes, however you will not be allowed access to your vehicle once you have signed in through the duration of the course.
5. Should I have a fresh haircut before I report?
 - Yes. You will need to reference Army Regulation(AR) 670-1.
6. Am I required to shave during the course?
 - Men are required under AR 670-1 to shave daily. Men are allowed moustaches but must be within guidelines set within AR 670-1. Beards, Goatees, and long sideburns are not authorized.
7. What type of makeup is authorized?
 - Females will not wear shades of lipstick and nail polish that distinctly contrast with their complexion, that detract from the uniform, or that are extreme. Some examples of extreme colors include, but not limited to, purple, gold, blue, black, white, bright (Fire-engine) red, khaki, camouflage colors, and fluorescent colors. Soldiers will not apply designs to nails or apply two-tone or multi-tone colors to nails as per guidelines set forth within AR 670-1.

FAQ:

1. Can I my family attend graduation?
 - Yes, upon course completion/graduation family members are welcomed to attend the graduation ceremony. Travel arrangements and lodging will be at the expense of the family members. There are several locations around Fort Sill/Lawton area.
