

Frequently Asked Questions

- Can I bring my family?
 - No. Family members are not allowed during the duration of the course.
- Am I authorized to take leave or pass during the course (outside of designated on-post pass)?
 - No
- Can I bring my pets?
 - No.
- How much money should I bring?
 - We recommend \$1,500 to make all the necessary purchases needed to complete the course. This will cover the cost of uniforms and toiletries purchased during the course.
- Can I bring my vehicle?
 - Yes. Vehicles may be driven to the course, but will be parked and non-accessible for the duration of the course.
- Should I have a fresh haircut when I report?
 - Yes. Refer to Army Regulation (AR) 670-1 for male and female applicable standards.
- Am I required to shave during the course?
 - Yes. Males will shave in accordance with AR 670-1.
- Can I wear make-up?
 - Yes. Females must be wear make-up in accordance with AR 670-1.
- Can my family attend graduation?
 - Yes, upon completion of the course family members are welcome to attend the graduation ceremony. Travel arrangements and lodging will be at the expense of the family members.
- What information should I bring with me?
 - Please refer to the welcome letter.
- When and where do I report?
 - Please refer to the welcome letter.
- Where will I live?
 - Dormitories for Army Medical Direct Commission Course students.
- What can I do to prepare for the course?
 - Begin a physical training regimen by referring to the Physical Preparation instructions on the webpage and study the Army rank structure for Soldiers, Non-Commissioned, Warrant, and Commissioned Officers.
 - Arrive with the correct items listed on the Packing List.
