

FURLOUGH UPDATE – COL HOSSENLOPP, COMMANDER, USAG FORT SILL

CHILD CARE FEES

When DoD employees present CYSS with a furlough letter, CYSS can adjust the Total Family Income by applying a 20% reduction to the furloughed parent(s) salary and adjusting the annual Total Family Income (TFI) accordingly. If the 20% reduction to the patron salary doesn't change the category, the patron stays in the same category. If the reduction changes category then CYSS will adjust the parent fees to the new/correct category.

When Patrons in CAT 1 (our lowest total family income level) present a furlough letter they will be granted an automatic 20% reduction in fees as the reduction in salary cannot impact their CAT 1 fee.

Any impact to fees due to furlough will only be implemented during the furlough period.

Parents will continue to have access to child care 5 days/week during the period of the furlough.

COMMISSARY

The Ft. Sill Commissary will close on Mondays beginning 8 July - 30 September due to furlough. In fact, all commissaries will close on Mondays unless this was a regularly scheduled restock day in which case those (we're not one of them) commissaries will close on Tuesdays. This plan is optimal for Fort Sill.

REYNOLDS ARMY HOSPITAL

Reynolds will have limited Outpatient Services every Friday, 8 July through 20 September. Inpatient and emergency services will be available 24/7.
