

MEMORANDUM FOR Fort Sill Gardeners

SUBJECT: Use of Fort Sill Garden Plots 2011

1. The following procedures and policies apply to persons who check out a garden plot and must be read and understood by persons requesting a garden plot.
2. The garden plots are situated in the 5400 area, just south and east of the Geronimo Road School.
3. Garden plots size may not be expanded. Plots may not be used until they are mark by DPW.
4. Garden plots are issued one per family.
5. Garden plot assignments are made at Sportsmen Services, Building 1458 with the priorities.

First week (7 - 13 Feb) - Active duty military may reserve previous year's plot.

Second week (14 - 20 Feb) - Active duty military may reserve a new plot.

Third week (21 - 27 Feb) - If plots are remaining retired military may reserve a plot.

Fourth weekend (28 Feb – 5 March) – Those that failed to clear plots last year.

6. All persons must check out through Sportsmen Services when finished with their plot. The final check-out day is 1 November 2011. If plots are not in good condition, then loss of gardening privileges will occur.
7. Policing of plots is the responsibility of the gardener. All items such as hoses, sprinklers, tomato cages, etc. will be removed before plot check-out.
8. Gardeners are responsible for weed control half way to the adjacent plot and maintenance of their assigned plot until the end of the growing season. Failure to comply will cause loss of gardening privileges.
9. Gardeners will do their own cultivation, planting, fertilizing, watering, weed control, and security.
10. Gardeners will be present at all times when watering to prevent waste and problems with neighboring plots.
11. Keep children under strict control to avoid damage to neighboring plots.
12. Pets are not permitted in the garden area. Report stray pets to Military Police at (580) 442-2101.
13. Drainage areas are off limits to vehicles.
14. Report all water leaks and other problems during regular work hours to DPW Service Order at 442-3251. On weekends and after hours, call 442-3775. Do **not** report to Sportsmen Services.
15. The Garden Plot Program is provided to enhance the quality of life for the Fort Sill community. This is your garden. Take Pride in your program.
