FISH AND WILDLIFE COUNCIL

Summary. This publication establishes the garrison Fish and Wildlife Council.

Applicability. This circular is applicable to all personnel authorized to participate in Fort Sill hunting and fishing activities.

Suggested Improvements. The proponent of this publication is the Directorate of Public Works (DPW) Environmental Quality Division (EQD). Users are invited to send comments and suggested improvements on DA Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to Publications and Blank Forms) directly to DPW, EQD.

1. Purpose. This circular prescribes policies, responsibilities, and procedures for the establishment of the garrison Fish and Wildlife Council.

2. References. Required and related publications and forms are listed in appendix A.

3. Explanation of Abbreviations and Terms. Abbreviations and terms used in this publication are explained in the glossary.

4. Records Management. Records created as a result of processes prescribed by this publication must be identified, maintained, and disposed of according to AR 25-400-2, The Army Records Information Management System (ARIMS) and DA Pam 25-403, Guide to Recordkeeping in the Army. 5. Responsibilities. The objectives of the council are-

a. Together with Directorate of Public Works (DPW), to advise the Garrison Commander on all matters relating to hunting, fishing, and conservation of resources for those activities to include the following:

- (1) Availability of recreation hunting and fishing opportunities.
- (2) Hunting/fishing safety.
- (3) Regulations involving hunting and fishing activities.
- (4) Military mission conflicting with hunting and fishing activities.

(5) Department of Public Works, Natural Resources and Enforcement Branch (NREB) standing operating procedure regarding hunting and fishing activities.

(6) Land, fish, and wildlife conservation.

b. To represent members of the command who are concerned with hunting and fishing on the installation.

c. To promote good sportsmanship.

d. To provide assistance and advice to DPW with regard to the management of resources that support hunting and fishing on this installation.

e. To maintain communications between DPW and installation sportsmen.

6. Organization.

a. The council will consist of one representative and one alternate from each of the following organizations:

434 th FA Bde	DENTAC
75 th Fires Bde	MEDDAC
214 th Fires Bde	USAOTC
31 st ADA	Retired Officer Representative
6 th ADA Bde	DA Civilian Representative (IMCOM)
DPTMS	Retired Enlisted Representative

b. The Garrison Commander will appoint the council president, retired military, and DA civilian representatives. The president should normally be an active duty colonel (06). The council may select a vice-president to serve in the absence of the president and to assist in the conduct of normal business. Selectee may be from the council or

the post at large, but will be subject to final approval by the Garrison Commander or his designated representative.

c. The council president may establish committees from council membership to assist in council matters.

d. The council will meet monthly or upon call by the council president.

e. Submit names of representatives and alternates to Cdr, USAG, ATTN: IMWE-SIL-PWE.

f. Representatives and alternates should attend each meeting of the council. Representatives and alternates will be voting members of the council, but if they are both present, the alternate will not vote.
