SUBJECT: Mandatory Notification of Issuance of Military Protective Order to Civilian Law Enforcement, CG Policy Memo 12-21

1. References:

- a. Title 10, United States Code, Section 1567a.
- b. Undersecretary of Defense memorandum, 10 March 2004, subject: Military Protective Orders.
- c. Department of Defense Form 2873.

2. In the event a military protective order is issued against a Service member and any individual involved in the order does not reside on a military installation at any time during the duration of the military protective order, the commander of the military installation shall notify the appropriate civilian authorities of:

- a. The issuance of the protective order; and
- b. The individuals involved in the order.

3. The commander of the military installation also shall notify the appropriate civilian authorities of:

- a. Any change made in a protective order covered by subsection 2; and
- b. The termination of the protective order.

4. Commanders on Fort Sill will issue MPOs using a DD Form 2873 (Enclosure 1). The MPO shall remain in effect until it is terminated. If the MPO involves any individual who does not reside on Fort Sill, commanders will use command channels through the brigade level to notify the installation provost marshal about the issuance of, change to, or termination of an MPO. In turn, the provost marshal will notify appropriate civilian law enforcement agencies.
