## Fort Sill Motorcycle Safety

**Motorcycle accidents continue to be a leading cause of Soldier fatalities and serious injuries Army wide. Training, leader involvement and enforcement of standards, leader and Soldier mentorship, along with composite risk management has been shown to reduce risk and injuries.**

**Mandatory Progressive Training:** prior to operating a motorcycle, military personnel will successfully complete an appropriate Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) course or State-approved curriculum for motorcycle operator's safety.

### Motorcycle Safety Foundation Courses

- Basic Rider Course (BRC): **initial training course for all motorcycle riders.**
- Experienced Rider Course (ERC): **military riders other than sport bike riders will complete this within 12 months of completion of the BRC.**
- Military Sport Bike Rider Course (MSRC): **all military sport riders will complete this course within 12 months of completion of the BRC.**
- Motorcycle Refresher Training (MRT): **prior to operation, all redeployed (6 months or greater) motorcycle riders will complete this course. Riders will attend this training with their own Privately Owned Motorcycle for which they are licensed.**
- Sustainment Training (ST): **every 3 years following the completion of the ERC or MSRC, Soldiers shall repeat the ERC or MSRC based on the type of motorcycle operated.**
