



9. GENERAL PROVISIONS (Complete blank spaces): The following general provisions, as set forth in Chapter III, DOD 4000.19-M, apply to this agreement unless otherwise specified in "Remarks" block below:

- a. The Receiving Activity will provide the Supplying Activity projections of support required to accomplish its mission. Significant changes in the Receiving Activity function, mission or support requirements will be submitted by the Receiving Activity in a manner that will permit timely modification of resource requirements.
- b. It is the responsibility of each agency providing support under this agreement to bring any required or requested change in support to the attention of DOL, ATTN: ATZR-LOP prior to providing/reducing unilaterally such additional/reduced support. Fort Sill, OK 73503-5100
- c. Activities providing reimbursable support in this agreement will submit a monthly statement of costs to FAO, Fort Sill, OK 73503-5100 for preparation of billing document, SF 1080.
- d. Manpower required in support of this agreement which is subject to return to the lending activity upon termination of the agreement: NONE (Enter number or if no manpower is required, enter "None").
- e. All rates expressing the unit cost of services provided in this agreement are based on current rates which may be subject to change for uncontrollable reasons, such as Congressional legislation, DOD directives, commercial utility rate increases, etc. The receiver will be notified immediately of such rate changes.
- f. This agreement will be reviewed ~~annually~~ <sup>triennially</sup> at least 120 days prior to the anniversary date. It may be revised at any time upon the mutual consent in writing of the parties concerned.
- g. This agreement may be cancelled at any time by mutual consent of the parties concerned. This agreement may also be cancelled by either party upon giving at least 180 days written notice to the other party.
- h. In case of mobilization or other emergency, this agreement will remain in force within supplier's capabilities, subject to normal cancellation provisions and will be subject to review at that time. This agreement will not be terminated if such action impairs the combat mission of the receiving activity as determined by higher headquarters.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. This interservice support agreement is negotiated and prepared in accordance with DOD Directive 4000.19-R.
2. This support agreement documents the use of FALCON Range at Fort Sill, OK, and the support provided to the 138th Tac Ftr Gp/LGX; 4200 N. 93d E. Ave; Tulsa, OK 74115-1699.
3. The responsibility for administrative and logistical services and support not specifically outlined in this agreement shall remain with the Commander, 138th Tac Ftr Gp/LGX, Tulsa, OK.
4. Support provided by this support agreement shall not be changed, reduced, or terminated unilaterally without consultation with the Receiver or Supplier.
5. The Receiver is a Department of Defense (DOD) component and is funded separately by the U.S. Air Force; therefore, support provided to the Receiver other than the use of FALCON Range shall be provided on a reimbursable basis if resources for the support are available at Fort Sill.
6. Use of FALCON Range shall be coordinated with the 301st Tactical Fighter Wing, FALCON Range, Fort Sill, OK (telephone: AV 639-2043/6300).
7. Point of contact for administration of this support agreement is the Installation Support Coordinator, Plans and Operations Division, Directorate of Logistics, Fort Sill, OK 73503-5100 (AC 405 351-4445/3108 or AV 639-3108/4445).

BB-Safety: Non-Reimbursable	Fort Sill shall respond to accidents IAW the Aircraft Pre-accident Plan for Fort Sill. Provide such services as applicable and required in order to accomplish the safety mission. If a mishap/accident occurs, it shall be treated in the same manner as an Army aircraft accident and all applicable contingency plans will be put into effect with the exception of convening the Accident Investigation Board.	Request coordination through FALCON Range Officer (AV 639-1240/6300), Fort Sill. Exercise every precaution to eliminate accidents whenever possible. Be responsible for accident/incident reporting and/or investigation for air/ground incidents involving the Receiver. Area of responsibility includes Fort Sill and adjacent lands/property subject to overflight and/or accident involvement. Abide by procedures established for use of restricted areas and upon request, provide any technical or operational publications relative to air/ground operations. Provide Fort Sill with a point of contact for all matters relating to accidents/incidents involving Receiver operations at Fort Sill.

SUPPLIER SHALL

Permit the entry of Receiver aircraft into Fort Sill air space and Quanah Range (FALCON Range) during time frames and dates approved by the 301st Tactical Fighter Wing (FALCON Range), Carswell AFB, TX, in coordination with the FALCON Range Officer.

RECEIVER SHALL

Request use of Fort Sill/Quanah/FALCON Range and use of air space through coordination with the 301st Tactical Fighter Wing, Carswell AFB, TX (FALCON Range Officer-in-Charge, AV 639-2043/6300). Comply with operational procedures established by 301st TFW, Carswell AFB, and instructions issued by the Fort Sill Range Officer.
