County music superstars Big & Rich will take to the stage on the Fort Sill Polo Field, April 25 as part of the "Tour for the Troops," sponsored by the Air Force Reserve. An American country music duo composed of Big Kenny and John Rich, both of whom are songwriters, vocalists, and guitarists. The duo has released four studio albums, one greatest hits album and fifteen singles. Their 2004 debut, *Horse of a Different Color*, featuring Save a Horse (Ride a Cowboy) is certified 3x Platinum by the RIAA and gold by the CRIA. 2005's *Comin' to Your City* is certified platinum by the RIAA, and 2007's *Between Raising Hell and Amazing Grace* is certified gold.

COWBOY TROY

Cowboy Troy is an American musician who performs country rap (also referred to as "Hick-Hop"). He has released four studio albums and one EP, including two releases on Warner Bros. Records, and has charted twice on the Billboard country singles charts.



KEN MORROW

Ken recorded his first album *Red Collar Roots* in 2011 which includes songs such as *Superman*, which was successful in a national song-writing contest. Ken's second album, *Ken Morrow Hired Guns*, was released in June 2013 with the hit single, "Man that Lost His Way."

LES GILLIAM

was designated the official "Oklahoma Balladeer," by the Oklahoma State Legislature in 1998. He is a native of Gene Autry, Oklahoma and is a singer, songwriter, and recording artist. In 2006, he was nominated for the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame and received the Governor's Arts Award for his many years of entertaining and helping to keep western music alive.
