CW3 (Ret) Dave Feller grew up in New Mexico. In 1987, he enlisted in the United States Air Force for six years where he served as an explosive warrant officer for EOD.

In 1987 he joined the United States Army as a 24T Patriot Mechanic. He held a variety of operational assignments during his tenure of service. His first position was as tactical control assistant, 1st BN, 7th ADA (PATRIOT), Kaiserslautern, Germany; where he deployed to Tel Aviv Israel with this unit to Operation Desert Shield/Storm. During this tenure, he completed the first manual engagement for PATRIOT battery. He submitted his warrant officer packet and enrolled in the warrant officer course in early 1991. There he graduated as a 140E distinguished honor graduate for the course. Shortly, after graduation he was sent to 2nd BN, 43rd ADA (PATRIOT), Fort Polk, Louisiana where he deployed twice to Southwest Asia for rotation. After completion of his second tour to southwest Asia, he joined the ranks of 6th BN, 52th ADA (PATRIOT), Ansbach, Germany for a tour of four years. While assigned there he served the EMMO and the Battalion Readiness Officer. He was promoted to the rank of CW3 by his mentor CW4 (R) Fischetti, a former comrade and trainer. He continued to train lieutenants in the art of warfighting as a tactical control officer. He returned to Fort Bliss, Texas where he served as an instructor for the warrant officer course for 9 months. After receiving accolades for his method of instruction and many noticing his technical expertise in ADA, he was reassigned to TSM for the last 3 years prior to his retirement.

His military education includes the Air Defense Warrant Officer Basic Course, HAWK Weapons Track and the Air Defense Warrant Officer Advanced Course. Additionally, he has earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Computer Science from Regency University in New York.

His awards include the Meritorious Service Medal (2 Oak Leaf Clusters); Army Commendation Medal (6 Oak Leaf Clusters); the Army Achievement Medal (4 Oak Leaf Clusters); the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal; the Southwest Asia Service Medal; the Overseas Service Ribbon (with 2 numerals); the Kuwaiti Liberation Medal; and the EOD Badge.
