

CW4 (Retired) Todd M. Piret

CW4 Piret is a native of Laurel, Montana. After graduating from high school in 1985, he enlisted in the United States Army and attended Basic and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Bliss, Texas.

CW4 Piret's enlisted career spanned 12 years while serving in 3rd Battalion 67th Air Defense Artillery Regiment, Kitzingen, Germany from January 1986 to August 1987. He was assigned to 11th Air Defense Artillery Brigade, Fort Bliss, Texas August 1987 to September 1989. After Ft. Bliss, he returned to Germany with an assignment at Darmstadt to the 10th Air Defense Artillery Brigade, where he served as the Fire Direction Center Section Sergeant. He then served as the Platoon Sergeant for the Fire Direction Center at the 32nd Army Air and Missile Defense Command, from September 1989 to 1992. During his second assignment at Ft. Bliss he served in the 2nd Battalion, 1st Air Defense Artillery Regiment as the Fire Direction Center Platoon Sergeant and 11th Air Defense Artillery Brigade Fire Direction Center NCOIC, from September 1993 to November 1997, where he reached the rank of Sergeant First Class. During this period he was awarded three Military Occupational Specialties, 16H, 25L, and 14J.

CW4 Piret was accepted to Warrant Officer Candidate School in 1997 and after completion of the Warrant Officer Basic Course was awarded the 140A MOS. As a C2 Systems Technician, CW4 Piret served in 2nd Battalion, 44th Air Defense Artillery Regiment, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), Ft. Campbell, Kentucky from 1997 to September 2002. From Ft. Campbell he was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 62nd Air Defense Artillery Regiment, 25th Infantry Division, Schofield Barracks, Hawaii. While assigned to the 1st Battalion, 62nd Air Defense Artillery Regiment, he deployed in support of OEF with assignment in the Combined Joint Task Force 76, Afghanistan. After the deactivation of the 1st Battalion, 62nd Air Defense Artillery Regiment, he was assigned to the 94th Army Air and Missile Defense Command, Ft. Shafter, Hawaii from August 2005 to August 2008. In his final assignment, CW4 Piret served as the Proponent Officer for the Battlefield Coordination Detachments at the Joint and Combined Integration Directorate, Ft. Sill, Oklahoma from August 2008 to September 2010.

CW4 Piret's awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (3), Army Commendation Medal (5), Army Achievement Medal (6), Air Assault Badge, and the Combat Action Badge.

CW4 Piret is a graduate of Wayland Baptist University with a Bachelor of Science Degree. He and his wife Wende have been married for almost 26 years and have one son, Jaxx.
