

## **BG (Retired) ROBERT H. WOODS**

### **UNITED STATES ARMY**

Brigadier General (Ret) Robert H. Woods is a native of Georgia. He is a 1979 Army ROTC Distinguished Military Graduate from Augusta State University, Augusta, Georgia.

After more than 30 years of active duty service, BG (Ret) Woods entered retirement in November of 2009. Prior to his retirement, he served as the Commanding General of the 32nd Army Air and Missile Defense Command from July 2007 to August 2009. His other previous assignments include: Director of Enlisted Personnel, US Army Human Resources Command; Director of the Human Resources Policy Directorate, Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-1, US Army, Pentagon; Chief of Staff, US Army Air Defense Center and Fort Bliss; Commander, 35th ADA Brigade, Fort Bliss, Texas; Chief, Air Defense Artillery Branch and Chief of Combat Arms Division, Human Resources Command; Commander, 3d Bn (ABN), 4th ADA Regiment, 82nd Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Personnel Policy Branch, US Pacific Command; Executive Officer and Battalion Operations Officer, 2nd Bn, 44th ADA, 101st Airborne Division, Fort Campbell, Kentucky; Assignment Officer and Future Readiness Officer, AD Branch, USA Personnel Command, Alexandria, Virginia; Battery Commander, C Battery, 2nd Bn, 60th ADA, Germany; Assistant Battalion Operations Officer, 2nd Bn, 60th ADA, Germany; Maintenance Officer, 2nd Bn, 60th ADA, Germany; and Platoon Leader/Battery Executive Officer, 1st Bn, 7th ADA, Fort Bliss, Texas.

Brigadier General Woods' military education includes: the General Officer Capstone course; the United States Air War College; Joint Professional Military Education II; Command and General Staff College; Combined Arms Services and Staff School; and the USMC Amphibious Warfare School. He earned an Associate of Arts Degree in Criminal Justice and a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology. He holds a Master of Military Arts and Science from the Command General Staff College, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.
