PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT	
AUTHORITY:	10 USC 3012
PURPOSE:	To provide Initial Entry Level Training soldiers the opportunity to reveal any concealed information pertinent to their enlistment contracts.
ROUTINE USE:	Normal office use. To obtain current information in performance of administrative operations.
DISCLOSURE:	Voluntary. However, failure to provide this information may result in soldier's separation from the United States Army for reasons of fraudulent enlistment under the provisions of Army Regulation 635-200.
