MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Consideration of Others/Cannoneers Care Program

1. Policy. Commanders and directors will establish a Consideration of Others (CO2)/ Cannoneers Care training and education program that incorporates traditional Army values, dignity, and respect into the daily lives of our soldiers and civilian personnel. Ensure every soldier and civilian receives the appropriate level of training.
2. Procedures. Trained facilitators will guide training sessions. The key focus areas are: Ethical Development, American Military Heritage, Quality Individual Leadership, Team Building, Equal Opportunity, Gender Issues, Family Concerns, and Health, Safety, and Drug & Alcohol. Commanders and directors will assess their organization training needs and report CO2/ Cannoneers Care training to their MACOM.
3. Post this memorandum to the permanent section of official bulletin boards.
