**TEMPORARY PRIVILEGE CARD FOR
VISITING ROTC AND JUNIOR ROTC PERSONNEL**

1. PURPOSE. This regulation applies to ROTC and Junior ROTC Cadets participating in orientation visits to Fort Sill, and establishes FS Form 421 (Temporary Privilege Card), see figures 1 and 2, which authorizes their admission to and use of Fort Sill privilege facilities.

2. SCOPE. This regulation outlines the policies and procedures governing the issue of FS Form 421 to ROTC and Junior ROTC Cadets during orientation visits at Fort Sill.

4. GENERAL.

a. ROTC and Junior ROTC Cadets are authorized the use of the following Fort Sill privilege facilities:

- (1) [Army and Air Force Exchange](#) (IAW AR 60-20).
- (2) Officers' Club (IAW AR 215-2).
- (3) Fort Sill Golf Club.
- (4) Morale Support Activities.
- (5) Motion Picture Theaters.

b. FS Form 421 is valid only at Fort Sill and only through the expiration date indicated thereon.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES.

a. The **Directorate of Community Activities (DCA)** will issue FS Form 421 to ROTC and Junior ROTC Cadets upon verifying that proper documentation authorizes their visit to Fort Sill.

b. **Director, DCA**, or a designated representative, will sign the FS Form 421 and enter the appropriate expiration date.
