USAFACFS Supplement 1

OPERATION OF CITIZENS BAND RADIO EQUIPMENT

Further supplementation by subordinate headquarters is prohibited,
unless specifically approved by Headquarters, USAFACFS.

AR 105-4, 22 September 1977, is supplemented as follows:

Page 1, paragraph 4, Policy. ADD subparagraphs c thru f.

c. Personnel installing fixed radio stations in government facilities will comply with USAFACFS Reg 210-1, paragraph 52(f), Care, Maintenance, and Alterations of Buildings and Structures. The mounting of antennas on roofs is strictly prohibited.

d. Personnel operating Citizens Band radio stations on the Fort Sill military reservation are obligated to make every reasonable effort to prevent their stations from interfering with the radio sets, television sets, and stereo/recording systems of their neighbors. Interference problems which cannot be resolved between the parties concerned will be referred to the Directorate of Information Management, this headquarters, by calling 351-6890/3850.

e. The use of a linear amplifier or any other device to increase the authorized 4-watt power output of the equipment is strictly prohibited. If the offending station is found to be in violation of the radio rules and regulations, the Commanding General can, after considering the evidence, have the illegal device disconnected; cause the station to cease operation; withdraw the privilege of operating on the Fort Sill military reservation; or recommend disciplinary action for habitual offenders.


f. The transmission of military information over a Citizens Band radio station is prohibited.
