

MEMORANDUM of INSTRUCTION

SUBJECT: 2016 FIRES CONFERENCE “Virtual” Attendance Procedures (3-4 May 2016)

1. Purpose. To outline effective operating procedures for the 2016 Fires Conference “virtual” attendees enabling maximum participation and user satisfaction using Defense Collaboration Services (DCS), 3-4 May 2016 at Fort Sill, Oklahoma.
2. All seminar virtual attendees must adhere to the procedures outlined in this memorandum to facilitate the effective collaborative transfer of information presented in both unclassified and classified mediums for the duration of the Fires Conference. Times listed are US Central Standard Time (CDT).
3. FIRES CONFERENCE DCS Operating Procedures:
 - a. Users click on the appropriate room link below (**CAC Login Required, Must Use Your Email Certificate**). **“GUEST” logins WILL NOT be accepted by the Room Administrator.**
 - b. Microphone functions inside the DCS room will be disabled by the room administrator. All user interfaces will be limited to the chat function. Chat comments **MUST** be limited to questions regarding conference subject material or to report technical difficulty. The sheer number of virtual attendees will not allow for personal chat between users while monitoring the conference presentations.
 - c. Questions are **Welcomed and Encouraged** during scheduled conference topics of discussion. Queries through the chat function must include the user’s NAME, RANK, UNIT, LOCATION and email address to ensure effective answers are provided.
