



FORT SILL POST CLAIMS
AFFIRMATIVE CLAIMS
UNDER THE FEDERAL MEDICAL
CARE RECOVERY ACT
AND 10 USC §1095



The Federal Medical Care Recovery Act (FMCRA) authorizes the Government to recover from a third party, for the reasonable cost of medical treatment provided to Soldiers (active and retired) and their Families. The treatment may be provided at a Medical Treatment Facility (MTF) or at a Civilian Medical Facility paid by TRICARE. This is not a claim against the Soldier! However, it could be a claim against the Soldier's insurance company. Please note: the injured Soldier is required by Federal Law and Army Regulations to complete all questionnaires and co-operate with claims personnel.

TYPES OF RECOVERY

Injuries sustained as a result of motor vehicle accidents (driver or passenger), pedestrian/motor vehicle accidents, acts of violence, slip and falls, unsafe consumer products, premises liability, animal bites, food poisoning, and many other types of incidents.

SOURCES OF RECOVERY

Recovery may be from vehicle insurance companies, worker's compensation funds, and other available health insurance. Recovery may also be made from the underinsured, uninsured, medical payments, or personal injury protection coverage of the injured party's insurance policy.

LOST WAGE RECOVERY

The United States is authorized to recover the cost of pay for members of the uniformed services unable to perform duties when the Soldier is in an inpatient status, on quarters or on convalescent leave due to his/her injuries. All recovered pay is deposited in the Operations & Maintenance (O&M) account that supports the command, activity or other unit to which the Soldier is assigned at the time of the accident.
