

ID cards holders can schedule appointments online

Did you know that you will be able to make an identification card renewal, or initial issue, appointment from the comfort of your home any time day or night? Beginning Feb. 1, the Fort Sill ID Card Facility will start a Web-based appointment scheduler. This is one more way we make your ID card issue experience faster and on your terms. No more calling in! No more waiting on the phone to speak to an attendant!

The Web-based application will allow you to schedule your appointment based on your schedule. You also have the ability to cancel and reschedule appointments as often as you like. You can still call the customer service number and schedule an appointment if you don't have access to the Internet. To make an online appointment simply follow these steps:
Step 1: Go to the following

Step 2: Click on the "Make Appointment" tab on the menu bar.

Step 3: Select the state of Oklahoma from the drop down menu and press go.
Step 4: When prompted to select a city, select "Fort Sill" and click next.
Step 5: A calendar will

appear with six weeks of available appointment times. You will be prompted through the remainder of the process. Note: Multiple card issuance (like for a whole family) requires separate, back-to-back, appointments for more than two cards. The Web site will alert you to all the information you will need to bring with you to your appointment. Please pay particular attention to the documents you
