

AMC FAQs for Army personnel

Am I required to be in uniform?

No. Uniforms are not required for AMC flights, but please have ready access to your DOD ID card (CAC) and your tags (dog tags).

Will my bags transfer to the AMC flight?

NO! Please make sure to collect your luggage from your commercial flight and take it to the AMC counter to be rechecked. Baggage will not automatically transfer to an AMC flight.

Where is the AMC counter located?

The SEATTLE counter is located in the South Satellite (S Gates) next to the Hawaiian Airlines counter. The BALTIMORE counter is located on the upper level of International Pier "E".

What do I need to present at the AMC counter?

In addition to your luggage, please have your DOD ID card (CAC), your tags (dog tags), at least three extra copies of your orders, and at least one extra copy of your Travel Sheet.

When do I need to report?

Check-in time begins 6 hours prior to departure. Duty passengers must be in line No Later Than (NLT) 3 hours 20 mins prior to scheduled departure. Space Available roll calls are conducted 3 hours prior to departure for all unclaimed seats.
