MEMORANDUM FOR Students, Army Medical Department Direct Commission Course

SUBJECT: Student Pass Policy

1. The purpose of this policy is to regulate the students' leave and pass in order to ensure the students remain focused on Direct Commission Course (DCC) training events. The rigor of DCC demands that students must focus on training. When discretionary time occurs, it is in the best interests of the Army, DCC, and the students that students are focused on the upcoming training events and preparing themselves to lead Soldiers in the Army.
2. When released from duty, students will remain within a 25 mile radius of Fort Sill, OK and must return to the barracks NLT 2145. This limit allows the students to enjoy the amenities of the Lawton and Medicine Park area while limiting the risk posed by greater travel distances. The Battery Commander may approve an exception to this travel limit.
 - a) All students **will not** visit any business on the **Off-Limits Restricted Establishments list directed by the FCOE CG**. This list is posted on the boards at the BTRY with all policy information. Violation of this policy will result in UCMJ punishments and removal from the course.
3. Passes (needed for travel outside the 25 mile radius) or Leave, IAW AR 600-8-10, will be reviewed on a case by case basis. These requests are reserved for students needing to attend to emergency or urgent situations. The Battery Commander is able to grant emergency leave if the American Red Cross has verified the emergency. All other urgent situations will be addressed to the Battery Commander through the Cadre.
4. A student's weekend and/or daily pass may be revoked if the following occurs.
 - a. If a student fails a graduation requirement, the Battery Commander may deny a pass for that student, so the student can retrain over the weekend.
 - b. If unforeseen circumstances arise during the training cycle, the Battery Commander may deny passes for all students to create space for training to occur over the weekend.
 - c. If a student fails to adhere to the Individual Student Assessment Policy.

5. Students may have access to their Personally Owned Vehicles (POVs) during DCC depending on parking availability and class size. They will be parked in the southern DFAC parking lot only. Students will not be granted access to their POVs during duty/training hours. At the start of the course, Cadre will inspect the student's POV for safety. A copy of the inspection form will be maintained in the student's file while they are here at AMEDD DCC.
