PCS, TDY, and Leave Travel – (Effective 16 Mar through 11 May) (reference

Department of Defense (DoD) policy, Stop Movement for all Domestic Travel for

DoD Components in Response to Coronavirus Disease 2019 dated 13 March 2020)

- ✓ Soldiers that have already started their PCS to a CONUS station by clearing Fort Sill and shipping household goods will continue to move.
- ✓ All other PCS and TDY travel is postponed until at least May 11th, request exceptions through your chain of command. Household good moves that are scheduled prior to 11 May will be cancelled. The transportation office will contact those affected.

- ✓ If you are currently on leave that ends during the stop movement window (16 March- 11 May), return to Fort Sill at the end of your scheduled leave.
- ✓ Leave and travel will be limited to 60 miles from Fort Sill. Exceptions can be granted for emergencies. Request exceptions through your chain of command.
- ✓ Those currently on TDY, seek guidance from your chain of command. Generally, you will remain on TDY until mission complete, then return to Fort Sill.
- ✓ Soldiers returning from any overseas travel will be self-quarantined for 14 days. Soldiers and family members in self-quarantine status will adhere to the necessary precautions.
- ✓ Individuals pending retirement or separation within the next 60 days are exempt from these stop move restrictions.
- ✓ Coordinate and speak with your chain of command for further guidance and instructions.

Increased Health Protection Condition Measures:

- ✓ Large gatherings and MWR events canceled for the next 30 days.
- ✓ Alternate sick call procedures in effect.
- ✓ Gate entry procedures include “no touch” on CAC card.
- ✓ Reynolds Army Health Clinic is implementing screenings through the east entrance.
- ✓ Food venues are carry out or delivery only.
- ✓ Everyone expected to use hand sanitizer and wash hands upon entering PX, Commissary, Gyms and other installation facilities.

Facility and Service Closures or Reduction:

- ✓ Freedom Elementary will remain closed through April 5th.
- ✓ Lawton Public School will remain closed through April 5th.

- ✓ Child Development Centers (CDCs) currently remain open. Services may be reduced to mission essential personnel should conditions change; command teams will notify those personnel that have been identified as mission essential.
- ✓ CDCs are conducting deep cleanings and practicing social distancing to keep them open and safe in order to support our critical mission of training new Soldiers for the Army.
- ✓ Corvias playgrounds are closed.
- ✓ Fort Sill Thrift Store is closed.
- ✓ Fort Sill Barber Shop hours are now 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- ✓ Fort Sill Cleaners: BLDG 2719 now open Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday from 10 a.m. 6 p.m.; BLDG 6036 now open Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- ✓ Bowling alleys will remain open; however Thursday/Senior League bowling has been canceled. The kitchen will remain open for carry out.
- ✓ Fitness Centers are limited to those with DOD identification cards. No guest passes allowed at this time.
- ✓ Fitness Centers are doing thorough cleanings of all equipment multiple times a day.
- ✓ Commissaries and Exchanges remain open with modified hours and restrictions on the number of critical items a patron can purchase at one time.
- ✓ Veterinary services are emergency and K9 services only.
- ✓ Fort Sill Dental Clinics are serving only urgent and emergency patients only.
- ✓ Fort Sill Museums are closed.
- ✓ USO Fort Sill Center operations are modified. (Closed on weekends and all programming is canceled to include weekly lunch and brunch)
