


Testing for COVID-19

Many have asked if we are short of supplies on Fort Sill to test for COVID-19. While we have limited supplies, we are able to test those that need to be tested.

The CDC states:

- Common symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, cough, and shortness of breath. Trouble breathing is a more serious symptom that means you should get medical attention.
- **If you are having trouble breathing, seek medical attention, but call first.**
 - Call your doctor or emergency room before going in and tell them your symptoms. They will tell you what to do.
- **Follow care instructions from your healthcare provider and local health department:** Your local health authorities may give instructions on checking your symptoms and reporting information.
