MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Residency Restrictions for Registered Sex Offenders, GC Policy Memorandum 20-15

1. Pursuant to my authority as the Garrison Commander of Fort Sill, I hereby establish the following residency restrictions for Registered Sex Offenders (RSOs) living in either government or privatized housing on the installation.
2. In order to protect persons living and working on this installation, RSOs may not temporarily or permanently reside within a two thousand-foot radius of any school site, educational institution, playground, park, or licensed child care center located on the installation. The establishment of a day care center or park in the vicinity of the residence of an RSO will not require the RSO to relocate. The two thousand-foot buffer shall be measured from the nearest property line of the residence of the person to the nearest property line of the school site, educational institution playground, park, or licensed child care center located on the installation.
3. I reserve the ability to make exceptions to this policy on an individual basis, as required by mission necessity.

5. This GC policy memorandum supersedes GC Policy Memorandum 18-07, Subject: Residency Restrictions for Registered Sex Offenders, Policy Memo 18-07, 20 August 2018.
