FIRST SERGEANT BRIAN L. CLARK enlisted in the Army in 2001 and attended Basic Training and Advanced Individual Training as an 13D Fire Direction Specialist at Fort Sill, Oklahoma.

His initial assignment was the 1st Battalion 6th Field Artillery 1st Infantry Division, Bamberg, Germany, where he served as a chart operator and radio telephone operator and computer operator, and participated in Operation Iraqi Freedom II. During his deployment he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant. Upon completing his deployment and his tour in Germany, he was reassigned to the 2nd Battalion 2nd Field Artillery, Fort Sill, Oklahoma where he served as Advanced Field Artillery Tactical Database System operator and Section Chief and would be promoted to the rank of Staff Sergeant. In August 2006 he was reassigned to the 3rd Recruiting Brigade, Cleveland Recruiting Battalion where he served as a U.S. Army Recruiter from 2006 to 2009 and would earn Recruiter of the Year Honors Fiscal Year 08 and Fiscal Year 09 and would earn his Recruiter Ring the 2nd highest award for Recruiters. In January 2010 he would be reassigned to the 1st Battalion 84th Field Artillery, Baumholder, Germany, where he served as a Section Chief. In 2011 he would deploy in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and serve as Section Chief, Headquarters Platoon Sergeant and Company Intelligence Support Team NCOIC. Upon completing his tour in 2012 he would then be reassigned to 1st Army East, 3rd Battalion 314th Field Artillery, Fort Dix, New Jersey where he would serve as Active Component/Reserve Component Observer Controller and would win NCO of the Year Fiscal Year 2013 and be promoted to Sergeant First Class in January 2014. Upon completing his duty, he would then be assigned to the 101st Airborne Division, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Battalion 320th Field Artillery and would serve as the Battalion Fire Direction Noncommissioned Officer. In 2016 he would deploy in support of Operation Inherent Resolve and would be selected to the rank of Master Sergeant. He would then be selected to serve as the First Sergeant of Alpha Battery 2nd Battalion 32nd Field Artillery and HHB 1st Battalion 320th Field Artillery.

First Sergeant Brian L. Clark's military education includes the Primary Leadership Development Course, the Basic Noncommissioned Officer's Course, the Senior Leaders Course, Battle Staff Course, Recruiting and Retention School, Basic Instructor Course, Equal Opportunity, Air Assault School and the Basic Airborne Course
